1. Introduction

1.1 Package Content

Start by making sure that nothing is missing.

The scope of delivery includes at least the following:

- 1 USB sound card TerraTec SoundSystem Aureon 5.1 USB
- 4 stereo cinch cables (1.80m)
- 2 TOS link adapters on 3.5mm jacks
- Quick reference
- 1 software CD
- 1 TerraTec registration card with the product serial number
- 1 customer service card

1.2 Layout of the Aureon 5.1 USB



A – USB port

B – Combined input

- Analog microphone input (for 3.5 mm jack)
- Digital S/PDIF input (with included Toslink adapter)

C – Combined output

- Analog headphone output (for 3.5 mm jack)
- Digital S/PDIF output (with included Toslink adapter)

D – Analog stereo input (for cinch plug)

E – Analog stereo output "Front" (for cinch plug) 1/2

F – Analog stereo output "Center LFE"

(for cinch plug), 3=Center LFE, 4=LFE/subwoofer

G – Analog stereo output "Rear" (for cinch plug) 5/6

2. Installation

2.1 Connecting your speaker system to the Aureon 5.1 USB

You can connect any active loudspeaker system to the Aureon 5.1 USB, whether it be a stereo, 4.1 or 5.1 system.

• Stereo / 2.1 speaker system:

Analog Out 1 – left channel

Analog Out 2 – right channel

• 4-channel speaker system:

Analog Out 1 – left front (LF) channel

Analog Out 2 – right front (RF) channel

Analog Out 5 – left rear (LR) channel

Analog Out 6 – right rear (RR) channel

• 5.1 speaker system:

Analog Out 1 – front left (FL) channel Analog Out 2 – front right (FR) channel Analog Out 3 – subwoofer (Sub) Analog Out 4 – center/LFE (C) Analog Out 5 – rear/surround left (SL) channel Analog Out 6 – rear/surround right (SR) channel

2.2 Connecting the Aureon 5.1 USB to the computer

To connect the Aureon 5.1 USB to your computer, you need a free USB Series A port:



It makes no difference whether the port is a USB 1.1 or USB 2.0 port; the unit functions equally well when attached to either.

The Aureon 5.1 USB is hot-pluggable, which means that you can connect or disconnect the unit at any time while the computer is running.

2.3 Drivers?

When connected to your system for the first time, the Aureon 5.1 USB installs a driver that is integrated into Windows 2000 and Windows XP; this process is completely automatic.

Insert the Aureon 5.1 USB software CD and install the Control Panel using the Autorun feature. Double-click AUTORUN.EXE in the root folder of the Aureon 5.1 USB CD and select the "Control Panel" menu item.

Don't panic, everything's going to be fine:

3. Control Panel

3.1 Play

Use this to adjust the volume of the individual signal sources; a master fader controls the volume from all sources.

You can also silence the master volume or individual sources by pressing the MUTE button underneath the corresponding fader.

Adjust the position of the stereo image with the balance faders below the level faders.



3.2 Record

In the Record window you can set the signal source that you want to record and its volume.

S/PDIF is a digital signal that does not allow volume control.

The "AGC" button activates automatic gain control for microphone input. This function helps you to avoid input interference and clipping, or to boost weak signals.

3.3 Speakers

Set the speaker configuration that you want use here.

You can activate every single speaker separately here to test them for correct wiring and function. If you click on a speaker to activate it, you will hear static from that speaker.



Under each speaker is a label. The first digit (1-6) indicates the output jack of the Aureon 5.1 USB to which that speaker should be connected. The other part of the display (+/- 20 dB) is a readout of the volume dials which are next to each speaker.

You can raise or lower the volume of each separate speaker by clicking the corresponding volume dial and moving the mouse forwards or back. This allows you to match the surround sound perfectly to your room and speaker system.

Clicking the "Reset Gain" button resets all values to odB.



3.4 Misc

Settings

You can save the settings made in the control panel as profiles and load the profiles.

Autostart

Automatically launches the Control Panel when the operating system is booted.

Colors

You can set the colors of the Control Panel to your taste here.

Language selection

The display language of the Control Panel can be changed with the drop-down menu.

About

This window shows the driver and control panel version installed on your computer.

4. Software

Bundle software

The bundled software supplied with the card can be easily started with the startup function. Double-click AUTORUN.EXE in the root folder of the Aureon 5.1 fun CD and select the "Software" menu item.
